

ASTO VIDEO COMPETITION 2019
TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The organiser/administrator is 'Association of Sail Training Organisations' (Charity Number: 1083059), hereby referred to as 'ASTO', whose registered office is located at the following address:

2. The competition is open to residents of the United Kingdom between the ages of 12 and 30 (as of 30th November 2019), except direct employees of ASTO and their close relatives or anyone otherwise connected with the organisation or judging of the competition.
3. If you are under 18 years of age, you must have the following from your parent or guardian. It is assumed, by entering, that entries by those under the age of 18 have both of these:
 - a. Consent to enter the competition
 - b. Their agreement to these terms and conditions
4. There is no entry fee and no purchase is necessary to enter this competition.
5. By entering this competition, an entrant is indicating their agreement to be bound by these terms and conditions.

7. Closing date for entry will be Saturday 30th November 2019 at 17:00 (UTC). After this date no further entries to the competition will be permitted.
8. The organiser accepts no responsibility for entries not received for whatever reason.
9. The rules of the competition and how to enter are as follows:
 - a. Entrants are to produce a video of less than 5 minutes in total length based around a Sail Training voyage they have taken part in.
 - b. The voyage in question does not have to fall within the competition entry period.
 - c. The voyage must have taken place on a UK Sail Training vessel and/or with a UK Sail Training organisation.

- d. The style of the video entry is up to the discretion of the entrants - examples can be found at www.uksailtraining.org/events/competition.
 - e. The entrant can upload their entry to the entry form, or upload their entry to any of the following public sites:
 - i. YouTube
 - ii. Facebook
 - iii. Instagram
 - iv. Twitter
 - f. The entrant must then complete the entry form and include a URL link to the uploaded video or upload their entry directly via the upload portal included in the form - link to form can be found [here](#).
 - g. Method of entry will not influence the judging result
10. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any footage they submit which include an identifiable person or persons have been taken with the permission of the person or persons pictured, and to make these persons aware that the footage will be entered into this competition. The persons pictured should also be made aware of a method to withdraw their consent (e.g. by contacting the entrant and asking for their image to be removed).
11. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice in the event of a catastrophe, war, civil or military disturbance, act of God or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of the Organiser's control
12. The Organiser is not responsible for inaccurate prize details supplied to any entrant by any third party connected with this competition.
13. The prize is as follows:

14. The prize is as stated and no cash or other alternatives will be offered. The prizes are not transferable. Prizes are subject to availability, we reserve the right to amend in anyway and substitute any prize with another of equivalent value without giving notice.
15. The winner will be chosen by a panel of judges appointed by the organiser, and publicly announced on or before Sunday 8th December 2019. This decision is final.
16. The winner will be contacted by email and/or telephone within 14 days of the closing date. If the winner cannot be contacted or does not claim the prize within 14 days of notification, the organiser reserves the right to withdraw the prize from the winner and pick a replacement winner.

17. The organiser will notify the winner when and where the prize can be collected from or to arrange delivery
18. The organiser's decision in respect of all matters to do with the competition will be final.
19. The competition and these terms and conditions will be governed by English law and any disputes will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England.

By entering this competition, an entrant is giving permission for their entry to be publicised via social media, online or at events, during and after the entry period, regardless of whether the entry concerned is deemed to be the competition winner. Footage from all entries may be used in promotional material by Sail Training International or ASTO.
