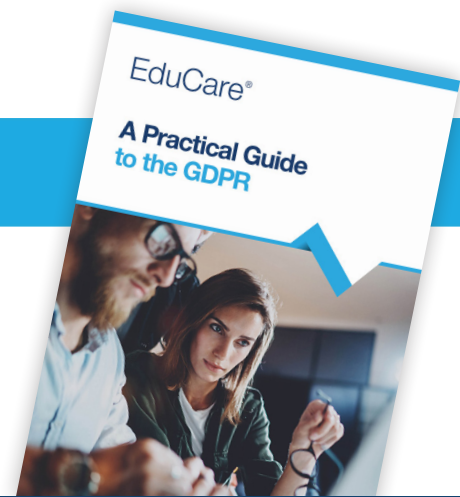


A Practical Guide to the GDPR
